

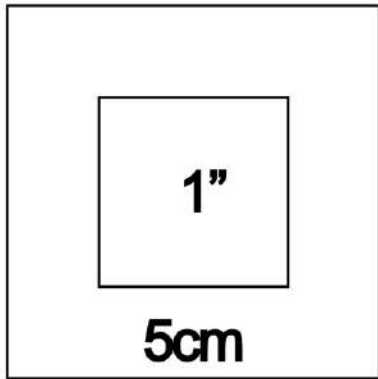

#### SUGGESTED MATERIALS:

Main: 100% Cotton Handloom Fabric – tightly woven. One can use cotton fabric of 2/40s, 2/60s and 2/80s count with a GSM ranging between 80 to 110

Lining: Tightly woven softer cotton (like Mulmul), or same fabric as main

#### ADVANTAGES:

Mask fits well on face

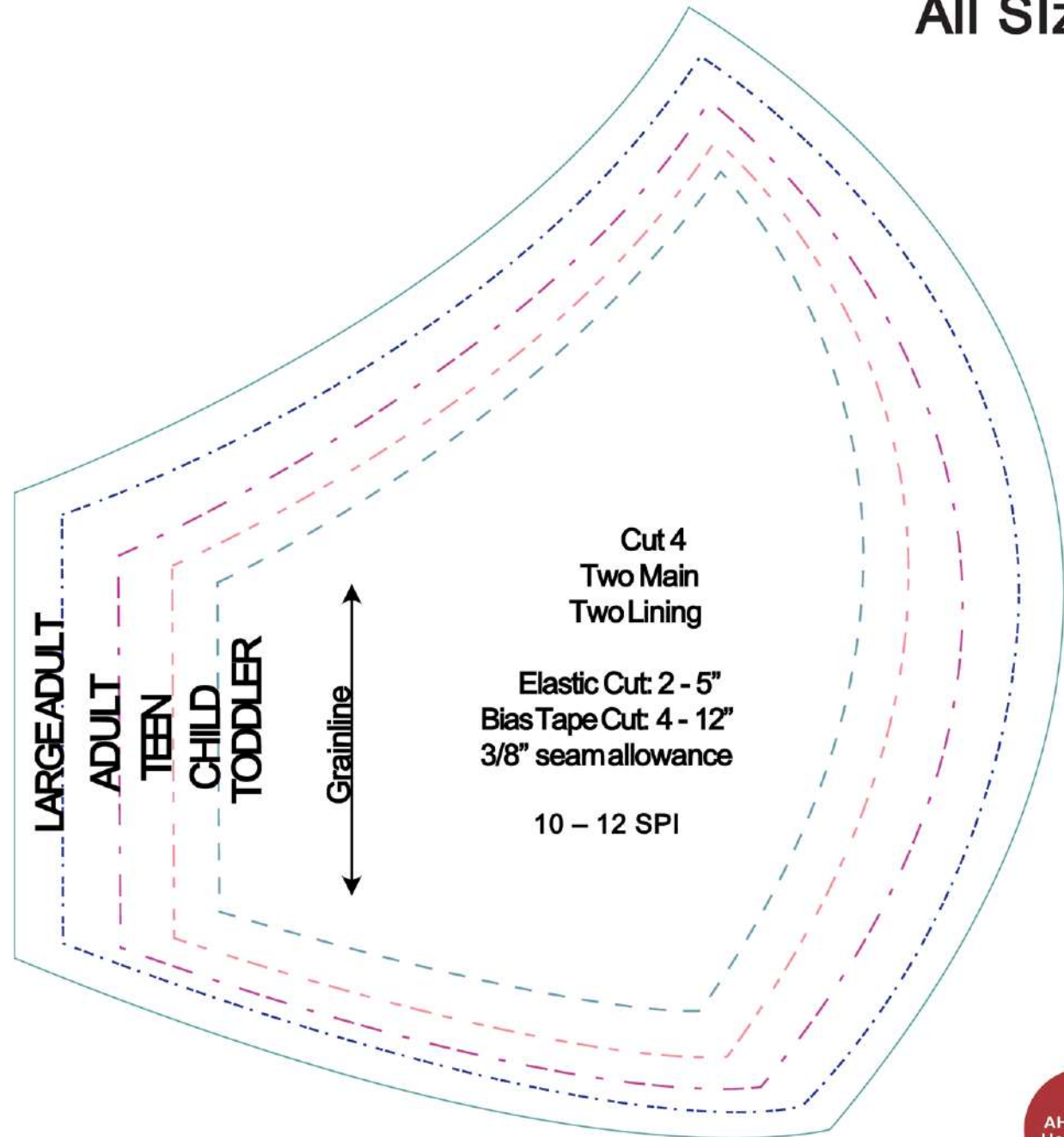
Can be worn both sides if using same construction fabric on both sides

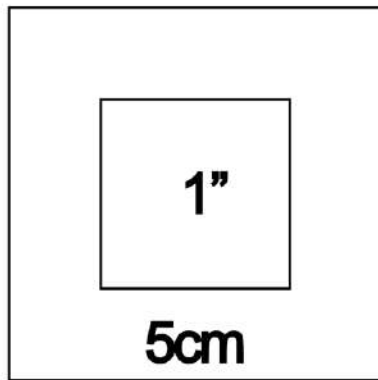

## SUGGESTED MATERIALS:

Main: 100% Cotton Handloom Fabric – tightly woven. One can use cotton fabric of 2/40s, 2/60s and 2/80s count with a GSM ranging between 80 to 110

Lining: Tightly woven softer cotton (like Mulmul), or same fabric as main

Filter: 1 Pc silk + 2 pcs chiffon

## ADVANTAGES:

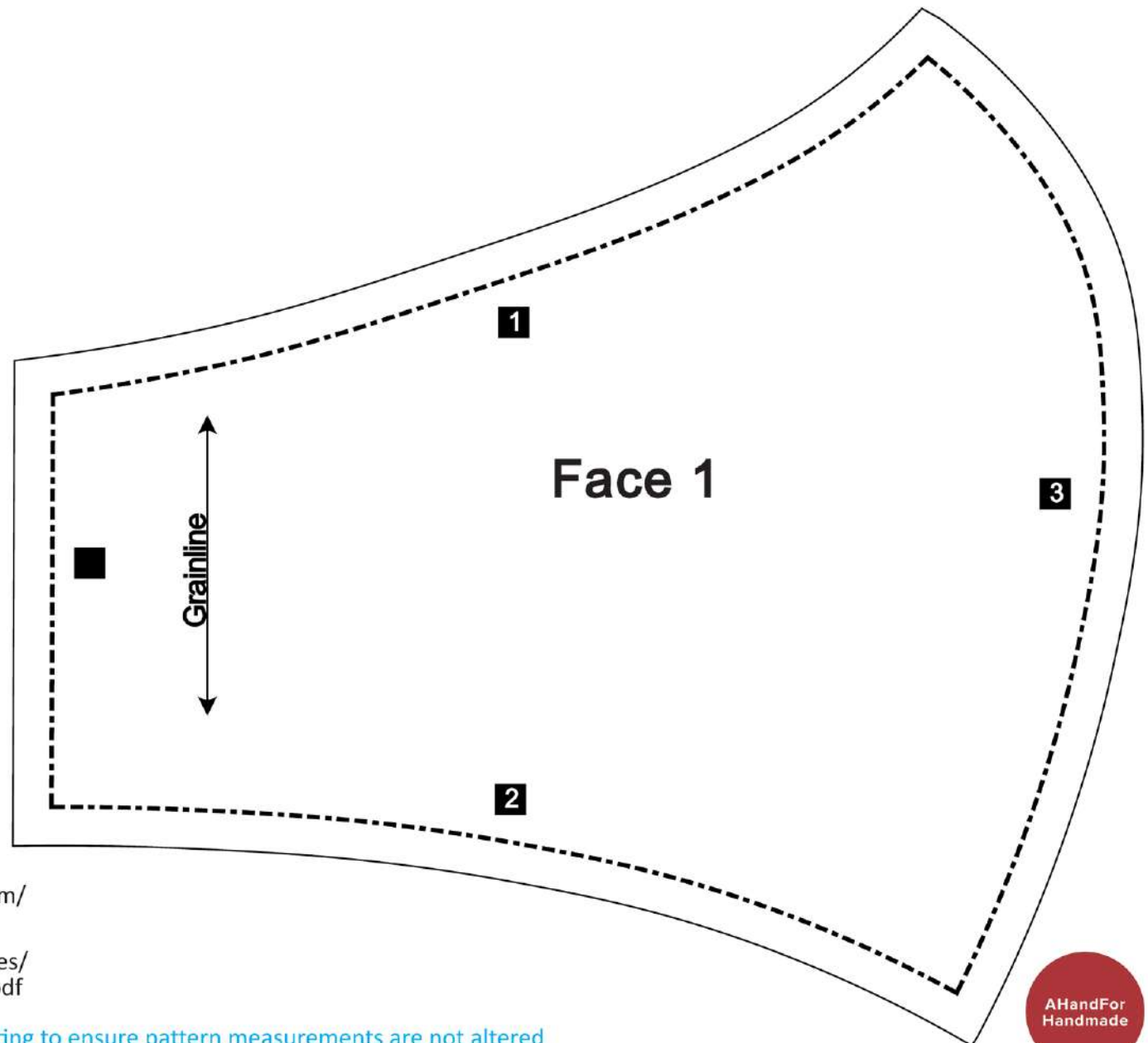
Mask fits well on face

Can accomodate a filter in the pocket

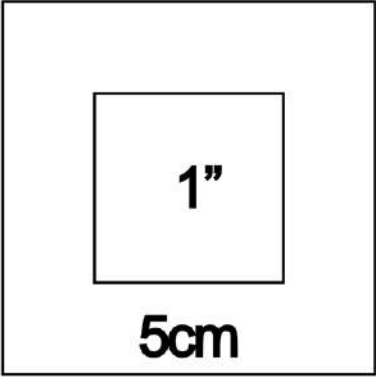

# Some basic quality factors to consider when making masks

- Fabrics should be washed and dried before stitching to prevent shrinkage later.
- Masks should be sewn well, with no frayed edges, missing seams or holes
- A stitch length of  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " or  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " on the sewing machine with 10 – 12 stitches per inch is recommended.
- Look at the mask as a complete product in itself as it has gained an important place in people's lives and expression of themselves.
- Consider raw materials that provide both functionality and comfort.
